

Family Hub Networks are launching in Lancashire.

On Monday 25 September, the Lancashire Family Hubs Network will see the opening of 10 Family Hubs across the county. Family Hubs are a place where children, young people and families can access local support. Together with our partners such as the NHS, schools, police and charitable organisations, we will be providing information, advice and support to families without them having to repeat themselves to lots of different practitioners. This will be Phase 1 of our launch; more Family Hubs and Family Centres will follow in 2024.

Our opening week will see each Hub hold a day-long event, where people can drop in and find out more about the Lancashire Family Hubs Network, visit a marketplace to see what services are available at that Hub and engage in family-friendly fun and activities, from arts and crafts to sports and dance.
